- Identify strategies for conducting streamlined and integrated HIPAA and HIV confidentiality training, including initial staff training and annual updates.



Prerequisite: Participants should have basic knowledge of Article 27-F and their plan's current HIV confidentiality policies and procedures.

Audience: Managers and administrators of Medicaid managed care plans responsible for:
(i) developing and updating their company's HIV confidentiality policies and procedures and/or
(ii) conducting their company's HIV confidentiality staff in-service.
